MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD



★ FLU SEASON IS HERE

Please remember that if your child is showing signs of illness, they should stay home from the Centre. If your child is sent home sick, they can return after being symptom-free for at least 24 hours.

Here are some common signs that your child may be too sick to attend:

- A fever of 101°F (38°C) or higher
- Two or more episodes of diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Continuous coughing, especially with a fever
- Excessive tiredness or difficulty staying awake
- A rash that may be contagious or is unexplained
- Discharge from one or both eyes
