★ Halve Cylindrical Food Please!

The greatest risk of choking from food is for children under five years of age. Foods most likely to cause choking are those that are cylindrical in shape, such as wieners, whole grapes, and hard vegetable pieces. Wieners, grapes, and vegetables, such as

carrots, are safer if cut in narrow lengthwise pieces. For the safety of the children, we require that all cylindrical foods be halved, lengthwise.

* No Hand Sanitizer Thank You!

It is a child care regulation that alcohol based hand sanitizer not be used on or accessible to the children. Several of our children have been bringing hand sanitizer to school either in or attached to their backpacks. In accordance with child care regulations, we ask that these hand sanitizers be kept at home. The children have the opportunity to wash their hands frequently and we also do have child friendly water based hand sanitizer that is available to them when a sink is not accessible. We thank you for your understanding in this matter.

★ Mark your Calendar!

We will be having in person Christmas Concerts this year! They will take place on December 4th and 5th during regular class time. The concerts will be in the music room of Emerson School. There will be a limit of four family members per child.

★ Accessible Parking Spot
